Invasive Species Removal Training and Demonstration Opportunities

Ohio State Extension, Soil and Water Conservation District and Natural Resource Conservation Service are training interested volunteers to give an invasive species removal demonstration at the Gwynne Conservation Area during this year's Farm Science Review, September 20th-23rd, in London, Ohio. The Invasive Species Removal Training will be on Thursday, September 15th, at the Gwynne Conservation Area from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The hands-on Invasive Species Removal Demonstration will be Tuesday, September 20th at the Gwynne Conservation Area from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. We will be focusing on the removal of honeysuckle, the fast-growing tree/shrub that produces small red berries in the fall and holds its green leaves longer than most other species.

One of the important roles you play as a SWCD or NRCS employee is educating landowners about natural resource concerns. Invasive species is a hot topic that affects everyone. As more people become aware of the need and benefits of removing invasive species, there is an increased demand for trained staff to help landowners understand how to remove them from their property.

We invite interested SWCD and NRCS employees to join us at the training day, or come to the Gwynne during the Farm Science Review, to learn more about removal and control techniques for a variety of invasive species.
