Be the Change for Clean Water Open Invitation to Help Protect Ohio's Water Two Ways to Be a Part of the Solution

Early in 2018, 10 SWCDs (Delaware, Fairfield, Franklin, Knox, Licking, Madison, Marion, Morrow, Pickaway, and Union) and their partners formed a central Ohio Coalition to inspire residents to “Be the Change for Clean Water.” The goal was to create mutually beneficial messages with simple calls to action that residents could implement to reduce nonpoint source pollution. These messages would then be broadcast



throughout the region simultaneously to amplify their impact. A website was developed to share these resources with the public, as well as provide professionals with marketing strategies such as articles, graphics, and videos that they could freely use in their own outreach efforts.

The Be the Change for Clean Water Coalition is extending an invitation to all SWCD employees to get involved. One way is to join us! We hold monthly meetings to brainstorm ideas on how best address our local needs. If you join, you will have access to a Google Drive account that houses all current and past messaging along with support materials, minutes of monthly meetings, and a spreadsheet to track the number of people reached during each campaign. In addition, the coalition pools together to purchase items to share, such as promotional flags, OMBEA audience response systems, and two banners (40 feet by 8 feet).

Another way you can help protect Ohio's water is by spreading the word! Tune into our website at BetheChangeforCleanWater.org to find the current campaign under “**Spread the Word.**” Campaigns generally run 3 – 4 months. Past examples include “Farm 4R Tomorrow,” “Plant Native Plants,” and “Donate a Kidney to Nature.” Even if you are outside the central

Ohio area, we encourage you to explore the tools on our website as they are easily adaptable.

When protecting our valuable water, everyone can be part of the solution. Working together allows us to effectively reach more residents and communities than we could individually, demonstrating the power of collaboration.
